

Commencing with the letting of May 15, 1986, the Standard Specifications of January 2, 1985 will be modified by the issuance of Addendum Number 1. Advanced Copies of this Addendum are attached to copies of this instruction issued under the 154 distribution list, but not to copies distributed under the other three lists. A general distribution will follow around April, 1986. It is intended that the Advance Copies be distributed only to those design squads that are progressing projects for lettings in May, June, and July 1986.

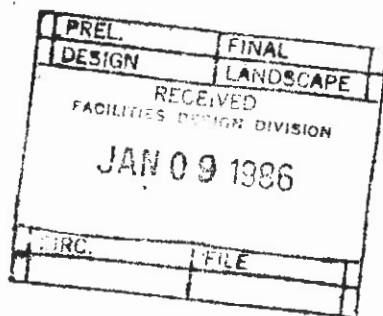
Generally, the addendum is a compilation of specification changes previously issued by Engineering Instructions. Notable exceptions, however, that involve an action by the design group are listed below:

1. Sheet Asphalt, previously included in Section 402, has been merged with other asphalt items in the 403 section. See page 13 of the Addendum for the new items and the details.
2. Transverse Drainage Interceptors, previously specified under special specification 15604.1501, will be a standard pay item. See page 38 for new pay items and details.
3. Under Section 655, we have included standard pay items for what used to be:

15655.0201	Parallel Bar Type Grate and Frame
15655.0202	Parallel Bar Type Grate with Cast Frames
15655.03	Frames and Grates-Casting and Fabricated

See page 49 of the Addenda for the new pay items.

Projects in the May 15, 1986 and later lettings (PS&E submitted February 20, 1986 and later) shall be submitted in accordance with the 1985 Standard Specifications as amended by Addendum No. 1.
