SUBJECT: INCLUDING LANDSCAPE DEVELOPMENT SPECIFICATIONS IN CONTRACTS

Effective with the October 9, 1986 letting, the Landscape Development Sheet (Form LB7a) will no longer be used in contract plans.

The landscape development information necessary to supplement the Standard Specifications will be entered on 8½" x 11" sheets for inclusion in the contract proposal.

It is intended that the sheets for the Proposal be generated by a microcomputer in a format developed in the Landscape Architecture Bureau for use on IBM compatible microcomputers with printers in conjunction with the Program LOTUS 1-2-3. Concurrent with the issuance of this Engineering Instruction, each Regional Landscape Architect is receiving a floppy disk and instruction manual. The manual contains blank sheets that can be reproduced and completed on a typewriter in those instances that a microcomputer is unavailable.

The new format has been designed to replace the Landscape Development Sheet only. Planting locations and legends for plant material should continue to be shown on the individual contract plan sheets wherever the work is required.

Regional Landscape Architects will coordinate with consultants to make sure the consultants have the information necessary to prepare and incorporate the appropriate landscape development data in applicable projects.

The supplemental landscape development information, in 8½" x 11" format, must be submitted for initial review with the advance detail plans on each project.
