

The Department has purchased a software package from AASHTO called Bid Analysis Monitoring System (BAMS). The component program of the system in use will enable the Department to analyze and compare project statistics for evaluation within selected geographic locations.

BAMS uses latitude and longitude for location purposes and keeps track of each fiscal share of a project. A booklet, to be issued separately, entitled "Municipality Latitude and Longitude Reference Document", dated October, 1986 lists the latitude and longitude for the center of each town, city, borough and village in New York State.

Effective with the letting of March 12, 1987, a statement is to be included in the PS&E transmittal letter which provides the latitude and longitude of the municipality in which each share identified in the Engineers Estimate Handling System is located. It should be noted in the letter that these coordinates are for BAMS purposes only. If a share overlaps political boundaries, the location reference would be to the municipality having the largest portion of that share.
