



Subject: CLASS A CONCRETE FOR STRUCTURES PAY ITEM CONSOLIDATION

Normally structural concrete items, with the exception of footing concrete, are not subject to quantity variations in the field. Footing concrete is substantially less expensive than general concrete and is subject to quantity variations particularly in the case of spread footings on an assumed rock elevation. Therefore, Item 555.0104 - Footing Concrete - Class A (No Concrete Class Substitutions Permitted) will be retained.

The following pay items will be used for Class A concrete:

- Item 555.0104 - Footing Concrete, Class A (No Concrete Class Substitutions Permitted)
- Item 555.0105 - Concrete for Structures, Class A

The following pay items are discontinued:

- Item 555.0101 - Concrete for Structures, Class A (Mass Placements)
- Item 555.0102 - Concrete for Structures, Class A (Primary Stress Placements)
- Item 555.0103 - Concrete for Structures, Class A (Appurtenant Placements)

These changes are effective for projects with PS&E dates eight weeks after the issue date of this EI.
