Attached are four BDD Sheets for snow fencing, which are effective July 14, 1994. They are designated BDD 94-44B, BDD 94-M44B, BDD94-44C and BDD 94-M44C. The BDD sheets with an "M" preceding the "44" are the metric versions of those sheets. Either type of fence detail can be used at the discretion of the designer.

The existence of BDD Sheets for snow fencing does not prevent any Region from using its own details for snow fencing. We would appreciate however, the chance to review any "new" details prior to their use for consistency and tracking purposes.

At the request of some Regions we have reduced the gap between the fascia and the fencing to close to zero.

The post connection details for snow and pedestrian fencing are to be the same to standardize that connection.
