The Materials Bureau will now distribute the Approved List for Materials and Equipment on an annual basis, in April. In the past, this list was printed and distributed on a semi-annual basis in April and October. This change is to reduce printing costs as referenced in the Department's recently issued policy regarding Graphic Arts Services.

It is anticipated that this change will not significantly affect the program. Monthly updates containing additions, deletions and revisions to the Approved List are being distributed to the Materials Bureau Engineering and Product Operations sections, Transportation Maintenance Division, Regional Construction Engineers, Thruway Authority, New York City DOT, Associated General Contractors of America, General Contractors Association, Nassau-Suffolk Contractors Association, Construction Industry Council and all Regional Materials Engineers.

Suppliers that attain Approved List status receive a letter stating that their product or company has been added to the list. This letter serves as proof that their product or company has been approved, until the next Approved List is printed.
