



TO:  <b>SUPERSEDED BY EB 72-036 EFFECTIVE 8/31/1972</b>	 <b>ENGINEERING BULLETIN</b> NEW YORK STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION
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Reference is made to Engineering Instruction EI-72-30 transmitting Standard Sheets 72-43A, 43B & 43D. These new construction signs have been incorporated into all contracts let since June 22, 1972. Please ensure through preconstruction meetings and follow-ups that contractors are aware and are in compliance with the new orange (and green on Engineer's Office) reflective material requirements. It should also be noted that all contractors now have the option of substituting barrels or drums striped with reflectorized white paint on nonreflectorized orange in lieu of the reflectorized white on black currently required.

A specification for M18P-Orange Finish Paint was incorporated into several recent proposals. The first section, titled "Scope" is misleading because the orange paint specified can only be used on drums. This will be corrected in subsequent proposals.
