Recently concluded negotiations with the New York State Department of State regarding our filing of notices of the restricted use of highways during construction or reconstruction requires a revision to the Construction Supervision Manual, Section 104-05 RESTRICTED USE OF HIGHWAY and Section 109-09 FINAL ACCEPTANCE OF WORK, Para. G. The requirement that we officially file our Designation of Restricted Highway, Form C230, with the Department of State in order for it to be valid also necessitates certain revisions to the existing Form C230.

Form C230g (6/77) may be used pending issuance of a revision, providing it is completed in accordance with the sample attached. The form is to be completed and distributed as follows:

1. "Part 155.8" must be entered at the top of the form, together with "NYS DOT" as indicated.
2. In addition to the description of the restricted highway, or portions thereof, and the Contract No., "This Designation of Restricted Highway shall expire on (date)," must be entered. The expiration date used is the completion date shown in the Contract Proposal.
3. The form should be dated and signed by the Regional Director.
4. The Region number and address also need to be added, as indicated.
5. Two changes in the distribution are required:
  - a. Add "N.Y.S. Department of State, Register/Compilation Unit, Division of Informational Services, 162 Washington Avenue, Albany, NY 12231"
  - b. Delete "Albany, NY" after State Police and send copy to local Troop of jurisdiction.



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The Department of State requires the original and three signed copies, one of which will be returned to the Region, after processing, with a stamp indicating its having been recorded. This copy should be forwarded to the Engineer-in-Charge for retention in the project records. In the event that the restricted highway designation is necessary beyond the completion date of the contract, i.e., during an approved time extension period, it will be necessary to file another Form C230. On the other hand, since the expiration date is now indicated on the Form C230, Form C231, Notice of Cancellation of Designation of Restricted Highway will no longer be required.

This procedure is to be effected on all projects awarded on or after June 14, 1985.

A copy of this Engineering Bulletin should be inserted in the Construction Supervision Manual following Page 104-5, pending appropriate revisions thereto.

DESIGNATION OF RESTRICTED HIGHWAY

Pursuant to Section 104a of the Highway Law the following described highway:

ANDOVER-GREENWOOD, PART 1, S.H. 9044, ALLEGANY CO.  
ANDOVER-GREENWOOD, PART 2, S.H. 1806, STEUBEN COUNTY  
ROUTE 417  
FROM: STA. "A" 11+66  
TO: STA. "B" 16+25  
AND ALL INTERSECTING ROADS AND STREETS TO THE LIMIT OF WORK  
DESIGNATED ON THE CONTRACT PLANS

which is being reconstructed under Contract No. D251283 is hereby designated as a Restricted Highway. Designation of restricted highway shall expire on September 1, 1980.

Pursuant to Section 1625 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law all movement of vehicles, persons or animals on such highway is hereby restricted and regulated in accordance with the determination of the Commissioner of Transportation as evidenced by posted signs, signals or barriers placed along said highway and/or by directions by an authorized representative of the Commissioner of Transportation.

Any action taken by the Commissioner of Transportation pursuant to Section 1625 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law shall supersede any other provisions of the Vehicle and Traffic Law where inconsistent or in conflict with respect to the following enumerated subjects:

1. Establishment of maximum and minimum speed limits at which vehicles may proceed along any such restricted highway.
2. Weights and dimensions of vehicles.
3. Use of such restricted highway by pedestrians, equestrians, and animals.
4. Parking, standing, stopping and backing of vehicles.
5. Control of persons and equipment engaged in work on such highway.

The provisions of the Vehicle and Traffic Law with respect to registration shall not apply to vehicles and equipment engaged in work on such restricted highways.

When used on such restricted highways, all traffic control devices shall be considered as official traffic control devices and shall conform to the manual and specifications for a uniform system of traffic control devices adopted by the Department of Transportation.
