


**ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION:** This Engineering Bulletin (EB) is effective immediately. It does not supersede any previous issuances.

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this EB is to announce the status of the attachments issued by Engineering Directive (ED) 99-001 (February 23, 1999) when that ED expired on March 31, 2000.

**BACKGROUND:** ED 99-001 was issued in response to an exceptional situation, involving friction aggregates, which existed in early 1999. At that time the Chief Engineer deemed it imperative to revise all the specifications which include friction aggregates. A Shelf Note (revising §401-2.03A of the Standard Specifications of 01/02/95), revised Highway Design Manual, Chapter 3, Tables 3-6 and 3-7, and numerous Special Specifications for Superpave were subsequently issued in ED 99-001.

Since the issuance of ED 99-001, the Shelf Note has been included in Addendum 2 to the Standard Specifications of 01/02/95 and the Tables and Special Specifications have been made available to designers.

**ACTIONS:** No new actions are required of any designers. Continue to use the revised Tables and Special Specifications until further notice.
