

We are submitting, under separate cover, transparencies and prints of Subject Standard Sheet.

Sidewalk ramps for wheelchairs are to be provided at all pedestrian crosswalks on Federal aid projects approved for construction by FHWA after July 1, 1976, and wherever feasible on all such projects approved for construction prior to that time.

Ramp types 1 & 3 are to normally be used. The type 2 ramp is restricted to locations where it is not feasible to use types 1 and 3.

Drainage inlets are not to be located at the end of ramps. Drainage is to be intercepted as near to the upstream side of the ramp as feasible.
