Effective immediately, the following pay item number and description will be used for all reinforced concrete approach slabs which directly abut a structure:

<u>PAY ITEM NO.</u>	<u>ITEM</u>	<u>UNIT</u>
601.0303	Class A Concrete for Structures (Reinforced Monolithic Approach Slab)	S.F.

Item number changes need not be made for projects which have imminent PS&E dates (e.g., four weeks subsequent to receipt of this instruction).

Plans which make use of Pay Item 601.0303 shall exhibit the following note:

"Finishing of approach slabs shall be done in accordance with subsection 601.3.08D - Finishing Integral Wearing Surfaces on Bridge Slabs, except as otherwise indicated on the Contract Plans."

Designer Note: Approach slabs with "sleeper slabs" must have the steel trowel finish requirement, and the asphalt coating requirement noted on the plans.

Estimator Note: Estimates for approach slabs with "sleeper slabs" must include the "sleeper slab" in the quantity.
