When a local road or street is necessary as a detour route during the construction of a project, the Department issues an Official Order establishing the detour route as a Temporary State Highway pursuant to Section 42 of the Highway Law. Heretofore, it was necessary to issue a second Official Order at the completion of the work to rescind the first Official Order.

To eliminate the need for the second Official Order, the following paragraph will be inserted in future Official Orders:

"FURTHER ORDERED: That this Official Order shall expire when Contract No. _____ is accepted by the Commissioner of Transportation in accordance with Section 44 of the Highway Law."

Therefore, it will no longer be necessary to process the second Official Order. However, the agency of original jurisdiction should be informed by a letter from the Regional Office that the Contract has been accepted and that the Official Order establishing the detour route as a Temporary State Highway is, therefore, rescinded.
