

The Department of Environmental Conservation is currently making a major effort to encourage the utilization of forest products resulting from the clearing of land for construction purposes.

This Department has agreed to cooperate by notifying ENCON of projects which will involve the clearing of five acres or more of forest cover containing marketable forest products (sawlogs, pulpwood, firewood, etc.). It is ENCON's intention to assist our contractors in finding economically feasible markets for the products.

Effective as of the July 6, 1978 contract letting, the Final PS&E Letter of Transmittal shall include a statement that the project either has or does not have a total of five or more acres of forest cover containing marketable forest products. The Landscaping Bureau will notify ENCON of the name, location and letting date for those projects with more than five acres of forest cover.
