The Office of Legal Affairs and the Traffic and Safety Division have advised that certain construction signs need not be erected and visible during the time that construction operations are shut down provided the highway (traveled way) is in a safe condition without obstructions or restrictions.

The three basic signs that can be removed or covered when the contractor discontinues his operations are:

1. W145 Road Work Sign Series.
2. D100 Beginning of Construction Series.
3. D101 End of Construction Series.

The Engineer, when he considers the highway to be in a safe condition and all construction work has been temporarily suspended, may authorize the contractor to remove, if no longer necessary, or cover adequately for the time period involved, the previously stated signs if they will be needed during a subsequent construction season. It must be clearly understood that these signs must be re-established prior to the resumption of construction operations. No additional payment shall be made for this work since it is included in the requirements for Item 619.
