ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION:

PURPOSE:

This EI revises Section 568 and a related Materials Specification of the Standard Specifications of January 2, 2002.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION:

- Transition bridge railing, bicycle and pedestrian railing, and bicycle railing, have been successfully installed using the special specifications which are being discontinued in this EI. The special specifications are being incorporated into the Standard Specifications.
- Cost Impact: None.

IMPLEMENTATION:

- Pay Item 568.32 is disapproved.
- Special Specifications 16568.22, 16568.23, 16568.24, 16568.25, 15568.51, 15568.52, 15568.53, 15568.54, 15568.55, and 16606.80, are disapproved.

TRANSMITTED MATERIALS:

- Shelf Note for revisions to the January 2, 2002, Standard Specifications Section 568 and related Materials Specifications.

BACKGROUND:

Transition Bridge Railings and Pedestrian and Bicycle Railings are used routinely on the Department's projects using a special specification. This EI updates the material call-outs and incorporates those special specifications into the Standard Specifications. Cement mortar pads are rarely used, and no longer merit their own pay item.
