


In order to keep the Highway Inventory Data Bank, which is maintained by the Planning Division, current and to keep this office apprised of critical construction dates, it is essential to report the subject information as soon as such openings occur.

In general, only pavements on new location, with all courses complete, need be reported since resurfacing is usually accomplished just prior to acceptance.

Reporting should include the following information for pavements open to traffic from now on:

I - CONTRACTS ENTIRELY OPEN TO TRAFFIC

Report the contract number only, eg., (FISH-RC, etc.)

II - CONTRACTS PARTIALLY OPEN TO TRAFFIC

Report the contract number, station limits on opened portions; whether the above is for both traffic directions or only one way; the connecting ramps, if any, leading to the opened travel-way and whether the ramps are temporary or permanent.
