

We are transmitting, under separate cover, copies of Standard Sheet 619-4R1.

This revised standard sheet supersedes Standard Sheet 619-4 issued by E.I. 77-57.

This revised standard sheet allows an option of various PVC pipes for the breakaway barricades. The revisions also include the tethering detail and material notes which have been added by special note since November 1979.

We have also added a requirement for mounting auxiliary signs to the barricade. The former method of fastening them to 2 x 4's wired to the back of the barricade presents a hazard, as the 2 x 4's are not frangible.

This revised standard shall be used in all projects commencing with the letting of March 4, 1982.
