Engineering Instruction 81-41 established a revised procedure whereby the Earthwork Summary Sheets (ES-1 and ES-2) would no longer be made part of the contract plans but still would be prepared as needed and made available to bidders for inspection and sale and shown as available on Form CONR 9g in the Contract Proposal.

At a recent meeting with the Associated General Contractors Specifications Committee, we received complaints that the sheets are not always available for inspection. This is to remind you that the sheets should be available for inspection and sale.

Since the time these sheets were developed in 1976, we have not required that sheet ES-2 be prepared on "small projects"; however, there never was a definition of a small project. An analysis of projects currently going to letting indicates that an ES-2 should be prepared for all projects that are at least 500 feet in length and involve at least 5000 cubic yards of the appropriate earthwork items (203.01, 203.02, 203.03).
